The title poem in *The Pennsylvania Pilgrim, and Other Poems* (1872), one of Whittier's more successful long narratives, concerns the 17th-century German Pietist, Francis Daniel Pastorius, who founded Germantown near Philadelphia and who, after formally joining the Quakers, drafted one of the earliest American antislavery statements. The volume also includes "The Brewing of Soma," from which the popular hymn "Dear Lord and Father of Mankind" is taken.
